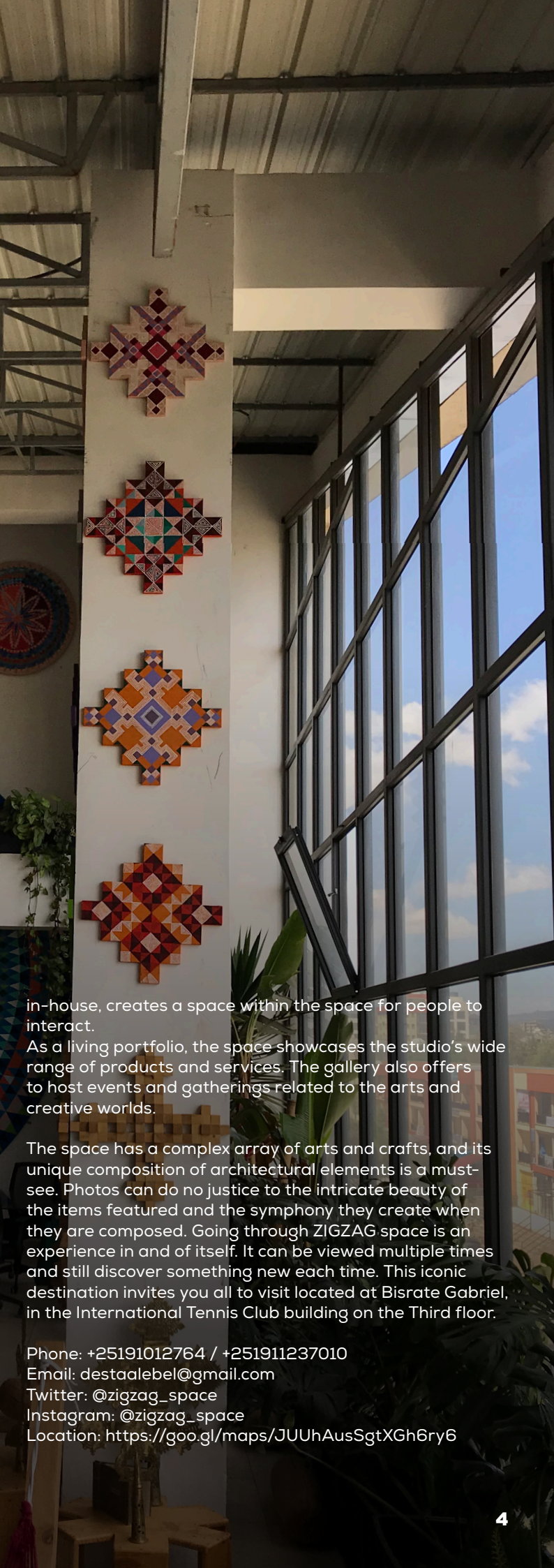
ZIG

A variety of creative outputs have come together to create the space. ZIGZAG space reflects over 20 years of hard work and the work of many people.

The space showcases a collection of paintings that heavily feature vibrant colors, geometric lines, patterns, and shapes. The paintings cross between the traditional Ethiopian and African arts inspired by the contemporary painting style. Ethiopian tilet, sifet, tattoos, and crosses have inspired many pieces.

Much of the furniture utilized to fill the space has also been designed and crafted by the team. The pieces follow the entire space's crafty approach and encourage users to think out of the box. The centerpiece of the arts and crafts center is the bamboo dome. The structure, designed and built



in-house, creates a space within the space for people to interact.



CHOKO MOUNTAINS ECO VILLAGE; ONE OF BEST TOURISM VILLAGES.

Each year the World Tourism Organisation publishes a list of the finest, most-sustainable and most intriguing small settlements to visit across the globe. In 2022, a total of 32 villages from 18 countries across the five world regions were awarded the recognition. The accolade recognizes rural destinations that are embracing tourism as a driver of development and new opportunities for jobs and income, while preserving and promoting community-based values and products. The initiative also recognizes villages for their commitment to innovation and sustainability in all its aspects – economic, social and environmental – and a focus on developing tourism in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

A total of 136 villages were put forward for consideration by 57 UNWTO Member States (each Member State could nominate a maximum of three villages) for the 2022 edition. From these, 32 were recognized as Best Tourism Villages by UNWTO.

A further 20 villages will enter the Upgrade Programme. All 52 villages will also become part of the UNWTO Best Tourism Villages Global Network created in 2021 which from this date gathers 115 villages from the five continents. The Network provides a number of benefits including onsite and online training, sharing of good practices and international brand recognition and awareness.

The 'Best Tourism Villages by UNWTO': Recognizes villages that are an outstanding example of a rural tourism destination with accredited cultural and natural assets, that preserve and promote rural and community-based values, products, and lifestyle and have a clear commitment to innovation and sustainability in all its aspects – economic, social and environmental. Choke Mountains Ecovillage, Ethiopia came in at number 11.

Choke Mountain is the third highest mountain in Ethiopia, located 300 km northwest of the capital, Addis Ababa. This ecotourism village has developed sustainable land management and is promoting solar energy, biogas and waste management. The local farming community in this village lives in harmony by adapting the ideology of Mulu ecovillage which promotes fair trade tourism, sustainable tourism development, sustainable culture and nature conservation. Additionally, the village aims to establish a strong community-based tourism approach by coordinating and hosting regular community events.

The village people have the knowledge and equipment to produce a range of natural goods including honey, beer, medicinal herbs, vegetables, coffee etc. for the locals, tourism providers, and visitors.

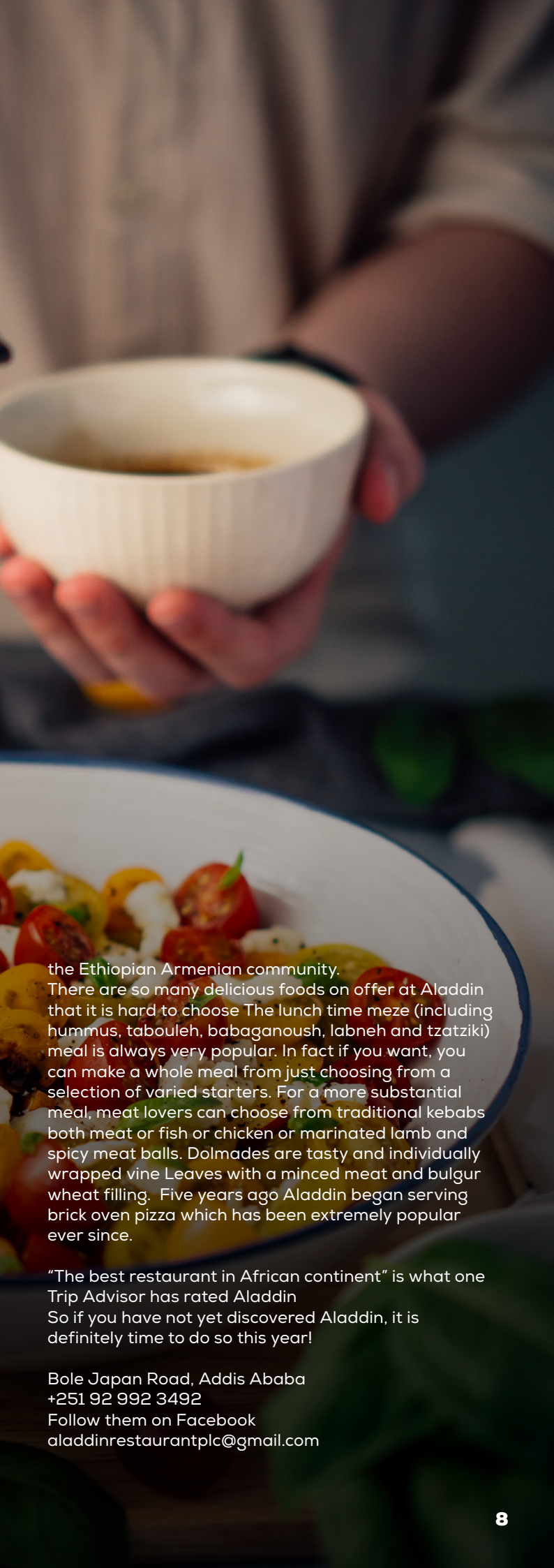

Aladdin has been delighting customers whether vegan or meat eaters because there is something on the menu to suit everyone's palate.

This cosy welcoming restaurant with indoor and outdoor seating in Bole has a feeling of being a family establishment which is exactly what it is. Tamar Kevorkian is Ethiopian Armenian and the owner of Aladdin Restaurant which she opened with her sister Kohar and mother Araky Kevorkian.

Tamar as well as her parents were born and raised in Addis Ababa. Her parents and grandparents were part of the established and well respected Armenian community who were involved in a range of different businesses across the city. During the military regime in the 1970ies however, many Armenians left the country but the Kevorkian family remained and have been instrumental in preserving



the Ethiopian Armenian community. There are so many delicious foods on offer at Aladdin that it is hard to choose. The lunch time meze (including hummus, tabouleh, babaganoush, labneh and tzatziki) meal is always very popular. In fact if you want, you can make a whole meal from just choosing from a selection of varied starters. For a more substantial meal, meat lovers can choose from traditional kebabs both meat or fish or chicken or marinated lamb and spicy meat balls. Dolmades are tasty and individually wrapped vine leaves with a minced meat and bulgur wheat filling. Five years ago Aladdin began serving brick oven pizza which has been extremely popular ever since.

“The best restaurant in African continent” is what one Trip Advisor has rated Aladdin. So if you have not yet discovered Aladdin, it is definitely time to do so this year!

ETHIOPIA AIMS TO CREATE 'GREEN CULTURE'

Ethiopia, the second most-populous country in Africa, is trying to create a green culture to win the fight against climate change, the country's Prime Minister has said. At Abu Dhabi Sustainability Week, Abiy Ahmed said his country was one of the most vulnerable to climate change, but it was "doing its part" to mitigate the effects. He said green jobs had been created across the country through different environmental initiatives. "We are committed to living in a sustainable and climate-resilient Ethiopia for the new generation," said PM Abiy Ahmed. "Doing so entails taking bold action now and instilling a green culture as we go along."

Ethiopia's Green Legacy initiative has helped create more than 750,000 jobs – mostly for women and young people – since 2018. The initiative has helped plant 25 billion seedlings within four years, equal to removing 64 million gasoline-powered cars from the road for one year. "The Green Legacy initiative, therefore, is our bold action, which has created national awareness on climate change and enabled the creation of green jobs and is making a positive impact on our surrounding environment," said Mr Ahmed. "Our initiative will certainly contribute towards removing the equivalent of hundreds of millions of tonnes of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and reduce deforestation."

Despite Africa's vulnerability to climate change, as a region it contributes the least amount of emissions. The State of the Climate in Africa 2021 report showed that rainfall patterns are being disrupted across the continent, glaciers are disappearing, and key lakes are shrinking. Plus rising water demand, combined with limited and unpredictable supplies, could intensify conflict and displacement. "Although we are at the mercy of high emitters, we are nevertheless committed to do our part," said Mr Ahmed. "In this regard, Ethiopia has developed its long-term net-zero and climate-resilient 2050 strategy, which will enhance our ability to plan for decarbonisation of the economy."

ETHIOPIAN SINGER SINTAYEHU BELAY HAS RELEASED HER DEBUT EP.

The project is available on all major streaming and download platforms, with the video of the song 'Abanegn' also out. The five-track EP combines retro Ethiopian sounds with a dash of the modern and incorporates traditional instruments like the kirar and masinko. It is also fused with West African musical elements. The album was produced by Girum Mezmur and Ethiopian artist Alemayehu Demeke contributed to the song writing.

The release is a collection of ebullient music set to capture the hearts of many. The enthusiasm Belay injects makes the offering highly listenable. Belay's style is in many respects similar to that of Aster Aweke and Hamelmal Abate, but it is the strong influences she has borrowed from traditional Amharic singing techniques that make her music unique.



The first female singer signed to the Muzikawi record label, in May last year, Belay first came into the limelight during the auditions for the Fana Lamrot music competition.

Belay was born and raised in Raya Kobo in the Amhara Region of Ethiopia where she attended primary and high school before moving to Dessie where she earned a bachelor's degree at the Dessie College of Teachers Education. Belay's love for music started at an early age. After losing her eyesight when she was only 15 months old, music became her main companion, but it was not until her family's landlord heard her singing that he knew she was a star in the making. He asked her to join a local traditional music group called Fana Raya and the rest is history.

RENEW CAPITAL INVESTS IN ETHIOPIAN AUDIOBOOK AND PODCAST COMPANY TERAKI.

Two

tech innovators have created a diverse online audio platform for amplifying Ethiopia's

tradition of storytelling. The company's name is Teraki, the Amharic word for storyteller, and its two founding entrepreneurs, Nahom Tsegaye and Abel Engida are developing audiobooks and podcasts in various Ethiopian languages including Amharic, Tigrinya and Afaan Oromoo, mostly written by popular Ethiopian authors. They're hoping to expand their company's global reach with a recent financial and technical investment by Renew Capital. So far, Teraki has 38,000 users listening to everything from novels, self-help books and children's literature to podcasts on tech, entrepreneurship, interpersonal relationships, spirituality and current affairs. They have also developed some 80 podcasts on many of those same topics, and about half of them are run like talk shows.

According to UN World Population Prospects 2022, Ethiopia has a population of 120 million, of which 70% is under the age of 30. The Ethiopian government estimates that there are an additional three million Ethiopians living abroad. This provides Teraki plenty of room for expansion. Teraki knows the diaspora is as Ethiopian as their compatriots living in the mother country, and they are confident their company can strengthen those connections, while reinforcing the linguistic and cultural identities of Ethiopian immigrants and expatriates, especially children enrolled in schools without their home languages. "It's a really exciting project because we're planning not only to shine a light on these local talents, but also trying to reach out to this global community" said Engida. As such, Teraki's technology platform



represents a wonderful opportunity to bring this massive Ethiopian community together to preserve its storytelling traditions while generating modern conversations.

The entrepreneurs began the project in 2019 with just \$2,000, using those funds to recruit Ethiopian voiceover and acting talent to record narrations of some of their nation's most popular books. As of November, the platform had an estimated 38,000 users listening to everything from novels, self-help books and children's literature to podcasts on tech, entrepreneurship, interpersonal relationships, spirituality and current affairs.

"Our generation is highly and increasingly dependent on technology, and Ethiopian youth are increasingly using Teraki to understand different current affairs and define our place in this world," said co-founder Nahom Tsegaye. "The youth really don't have that connection with their elders and those storytellers," said co-founder Abel Engida.

Teraki says over half of its more than 80 podcasts also create opportunities for Ethiopians to create a greater sense of community through online conversation. "We wanted to give a platform to everyone to discuss what it's like to experience feminism, sexism, relationships and other topics and what they mean in our own context," said Engida.

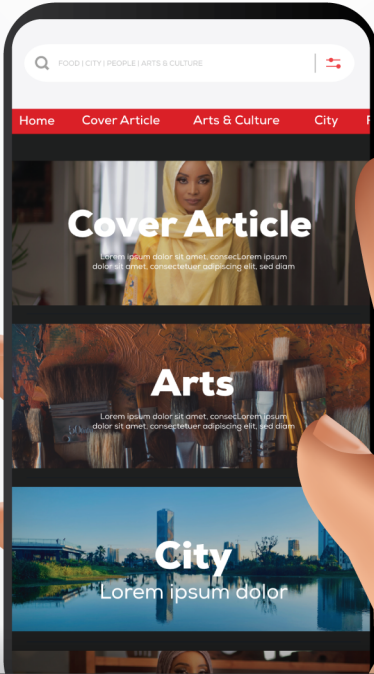


