And all our hopes and dreams are within reach.



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WHAT IS THE MESKEL SQUARE PROJECT

Meskel Square is known most notably for the annual Meskel celebration every Sept 27th – long ago it was an actual green square but as more cars appeared on the roads, a junction of vehicles crisscrossing from all directions took precedence. Prior to the new development, Meskel Square was also known however for impromptu football matches and joggers at all times of the day as well as people just hanging out; renamed Revolution Square for a period during the Derg period. It is probably considered the most famous square in Addis even though it isn't really a square anymore!

Today, the area is officially known as the Meskel Square Municipality Rehabilitation project and part of Prime Minister Abiy's Greening of Addis beautification project. There are around 5,000 Chinese and Ethiopian construction workers and it still resembles a construction site within a deep crater but when completed (no date confirmed yet although it is more than half way completed), it will contain an artificial lake, moveable trees, artificial lights and a massive underground parking lot to accommodate vehicles (1,400) of anticipated visitors. The design will have vehicles travelling under the surface of the square leaving the ground level free for pedestrians.. The project will also include six LED screens and around 30 retail shops, a library, café and restaurants and statues which are registered by UNESCO highlighting the cultures and traditions of all the nations and nationalities within Ethiopia. It will offer both retail and recreation aimed at people of all ages to come and spend the day enjoying their time.

Although the construction has been undertaken by the Chinese, the whole complex design was created by three Ethiopian architects.

GUMMA FILM AWARD

RECOGNIZING ETHIOPIAN CINEMA

The 7th Gumma Film Award is an Ethiopian movie award, with the sole aim of acknowledging and honoring the best Ethiopian performing films and artists. It is exclusively sponsored by Bedele Special.

Ethiopia cinema and the Ethiopian film industry in general is a relatively recent phenomenon in Ethiopia. The Ethiopian film industry is growing but still faces challenges that have prevented it from fully flourishing. Historically, live stage theater enjoyed more popularity in Ethiopia and created a handful of relatively successful stage actors.

More than 75 Ethiopian movies were produced during the 2011-2012 (Ethiopian calendar) and of these, 45 films were registered and will be nominated in 18 different categories to receive the Gumma Film Award. Last year the Best Film of the year 2011 went to Yelomi Shita. Solomon Bogale took home Best Actor and Elizabeth Melaku took home Best Actress awards of the year. One of the leading categories among the Gumma Film Award is one given for Lifetime Achievement; last year it went to 88 year old director Michel Papatakis, who created Ethiopia's first 35mm color film called Gumma, during the reign of Emperor Haile Sellasie I.

According to the organizers, Gumma Film Award envisions cultivating and scaling up the Ethiopian film industry to a world class standard, with the vision of creating a platform for Ethiopian films to promote Ethiopian culture, values and stories worldwide. The Gumma Film Award was created by director Yonas Berhane Mewa, founder and owner of Ethio Films Production.

The months of February and March have graced us with artistic and cultural events that have revived the city's spirit since the beginning of COVID-19 which preoccupied our minds.

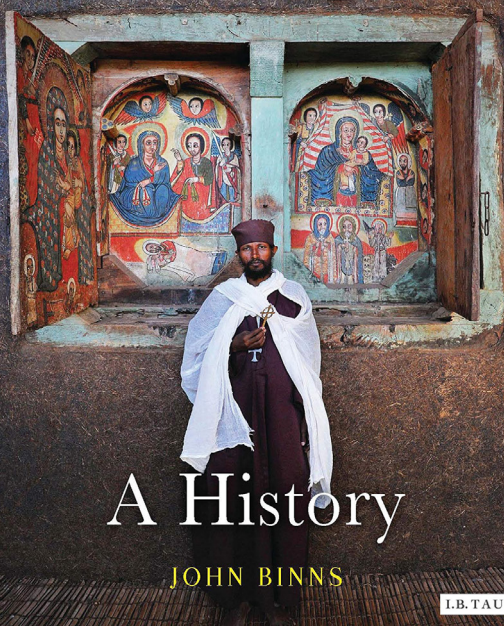
Music festivals able to bring the South African Artist Master KG and the Tanzanian Artist Diamond PlatnumZ have been a part of the city's spiritual revival that followed the release of the long awaited album from Tilahun Gessess. This was followed by several festivals throughout the city to celebrate the Battle of Adwa and the start of the Orthodox pre Easter 55 day fast.

Visual art galleries have also been a part of the hype in different locations across Addis, including the second art exhibition of the Addis Arts Alive initiative that was presented at the Hyatt Regency of Addis Ababa by Prologue BCW Marketing; a solo exhibition of Seyoum Ayalew (the first after eight years), and then the Adwa series of exhibitions at the National and Addis Ababa museums followed by others.

The annual Artisan and Designer bazaar took place at the Golf Club and the SheCovery Festival held at Zoma Museum was also a reminder that we needed these type of outings, entertainment and spoil ourselves while also encouraging the artists and artisans.

At last we are eagerly anticipating the Art Sale Bazaar at the Hilton Hotel on the 27th and the 28th of March that will have more than 100 visual artists participating, along with the Pioneer Veggie and Vegan festival in mid April.

THE Orthodox Church of Ethiopia



The Orthodox Church of Ethiopia: A History A must-read book on the History of Ethiopian Orthodox Christianity that Shaped Ethiopia as a country. Author John Binns is Visiting Professor of Eastern Orthodox Studies at the University of Cambridge and Priest of Great St Mary's, Cambridge (UK). He serves also as Chairperson of the charity Partners for Change to Ethiopia.

Surrounded by steep escarpments to the north, south and east, Ethiopia has always been geographically and culturally set apart. It has the longest archaeological record of any country in the world: indeed, this precipitous mountain land was where the human race began. It is also home to an ancient church with a remarkable legacy. The Church of Ethiopia is the only pre-colonial church in sub-Saharan Africa; today it has a membership of around forty million and is rapidly growing. This book is the first major study of a community which has developed a distinctive approach different from all other churches. John Binns explains how its special features have shaped the life of the Ethiopian people, and how political changes since the overthrow of Haile Selassie have forced the Church to rethink its identity and mission. He discusses the famous rock-hewn churches; the Ark of the Covenant (claimed by the Church and housed in Aksum); medieval monasticism; relations with the Coptic Church; centuries of co-existence with Islam; missionary activity; and the Church's venerable oral traditions of poetic allegorical reflection. WINNER OF AFRICAN CODE CHALLENGE



10 years old Ethiopian Soliyana Giza has won the 2020 AfriCAN Code Challenge (ACC) competition a newly launched continent-wide tech competition where young people were invited to create an educational computer game. According to organizers Soliyana’s submission called “Mathstainment” won the Pan-African prize. The ACC competition invited youths to create an educational computer game. She won first place for the Pan-African prize with participants from 54 countries of which the top 3 contestants were all females aged 10 – 16 years, with Soliyana aged 10 years old. Children from 54 countries shared their vision about future education with their entries. Soliana showed ability with her game design to devise a project that would solve community issues by coding and communicating. Her work also included an awareness about Covid-19.

The AfriCAN Code Challenge is an exciting AfriCAN Code Challenge where youth aged 8 – 16 were tasked with coding a game using the Scratch programming language that connects with the ‘Courageous Coders’ theme to answer the question: “How will your tech change the future of education?”

In her video presentation Soliyana explains that her app “is not only a game,” but also “creates awareness about COVID-19.”

The Addis Ababa transport authority said it has finalized preparations to replace 10,500 blue and white Lada taxi cars with new ones. The authority recently signed an agreement with associations to replace the classic Lada taxis - they are more than 50 years old.

According to Engineer Sitotaw Akal, head of Addis Ababa transport bureau, the Commercial Bank of Ethiopia (CBE) has made available a 6 billion birr loan for the associations.

The new and updated taxi vehicles will resume services within the coming four months.

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STREET HEART TWO CONTINENTS, ONE BEAT.

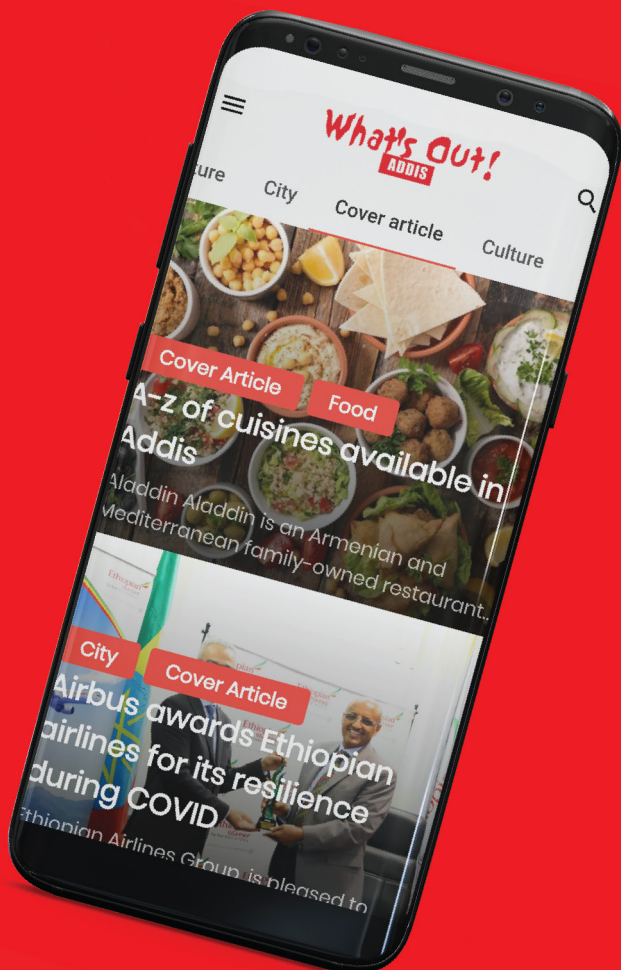
A street-art competition has been launched by the Delegation of the European Union to the African Union. The initiative will involve street artists from Africa and Europe to visualise dialogue, open-mindedness, human dignity, and mutual respect between Africa and Europe. Through the universal language of art the aim is to bring the two continents together.

Street artists from any European Union or African Union member state over the age of 18 can apply. Candidates are requested to propose a creative concept and adapt it to two different areas as indicated in the guidelines. Four winners will be selected – two from each continent. They will be invited to perform their creative work on the streets of Addis Ababa, in May 2021; in celebration of Europe Day (9 May), Africa Day (23 May) and the year of Culture of the African Union. The costs of their trip will be covered and each winner will receive €3,000.

The artwork should draw its inspiration from the shared values and goals that are reflected in the Africa EU partnership. It should also illustrate the cooperative principles that bind both Unions, in a positive and optimistic outlook of a common future. The applicants should provide a portfolio demonstrating past experiences with similar projects as well. Through this competition, the EU Delegation to the African Union wishes also to provide a message of support to artists and the creative sector.

HUMMUS

I'm in the kitchen almost daily; either cooking a meal at home, at one of the restaurants helping my team or catering at someone's home. I have found that the meals I enjoy consuming the most are the ones that are also the easiest to make. At home, I go out of my way to cook using locally sourced ingredients which guarantees freshness.

This month, I would like to share with you my very easy to make hummus recipe. I usually make pita bread at home or I cut up carrots to dip in the hummus. I always have hummus in my fridge because it's easy to make, it's a healthy treat and I can find all the ingredients in Addis!

INGREDIENTS

- 2 CUPS OF BOILED CHICKPEAS
- ½ CUP OF TAHINI (SESAME PASTE)
- 2 TABLESPOONS (AND 1 TEASPOON) OF EXTRA VIRGIN OIL (BUT ANY OIL WILL DO)
- 3 TABLESPOONS LIME JUICE
- 3 TABLESPOONS OF WATER (IF NEEDED)
- 2 CLOVES OF GARLIC
- ½ TEASPOONS OF SALT
- 1/2 TEASPOON OF CHOPPED PARSLEY (FOR GARNISH)

PREPARATION

It's an easy one step process! Put all the ingredients (except the water, the parsley and the 1 teaspoon olive oil) in the blender and process until it's smooth. Add as much water as necessary until you have the consistency you desire.

Spoon the hummus into a bowl and drizzle over one teaspoon of olive oil and sprinkle on parsley for garnish. Serve with pita bread, crackers, carrots or celery sticks.
