I'm busy being present in my life.



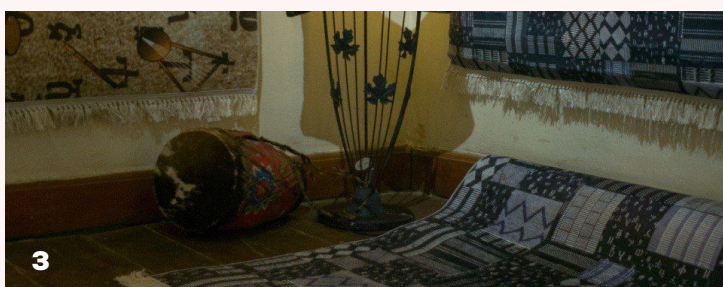


# AKLILL CARPETS

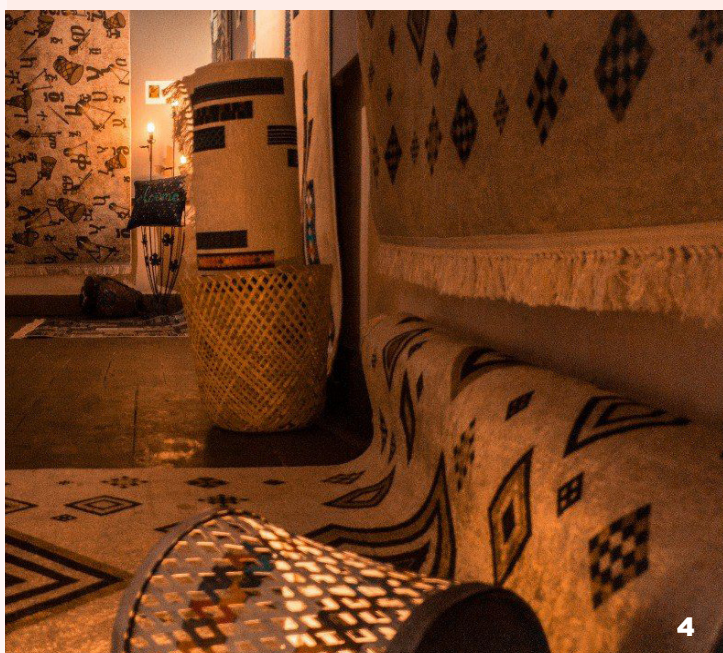

Afropian is a Panafrican brand focusing on Ethiopia as it connects to the rest of Africa. It is 100% Handmade in Africa! As a Cameroonian who calls beautiful Ethiopia home, founder and creative director Hortense Mbea wanted to bring what she has gleaned from her extensive travels on the continent back to her second home. The brand builds on luxurious, traditionally handcrafted textiles and other art from across the continent. In these days of African Renaissance, they think it is time now to focus on what has always made Africa great - creativity, savoir-faire and artisanal know-how!



Artisans come from across the continent including Tunisia, Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, Mali, Burkina Faso, Sénégal, Benin, Cameroon and Ethiopia.

Customers can visit the Addis showroom in Gurdshola (by appointment) and soon there will be a flagship store in Addis. Ethiopian artisans include Gabitiks (handwoven cotton blankets) and artisans that craft the iconic Ethiopian crosses in bronze, silver and brass. Gabitiks are created by mixing Batik from Cote d'Ivoire' gabi on one side and batik on the other.

Hortense moved from France to Addis in 2002 to start a career as an interpreter. A position with the African Development Bank took her away from 2012-17.

However, upon her return Hortense wanted to tap into her creativity and establish Afropian as a way to show Ethiopians how well they blend with the rest of the continent and to highlight how similar African cultures are. "I also aim to showcase African excellence, tell our true story and take people on a journey through the continent and through time".

# LA GARE: FROM RAILWAY HUB TO URBAN DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

La Gare was once the main railway station in Addis Ababa with its magnificent grand terminal building. En route towns grew along the railway line from Addis to Djibouti with expanded opportunities for trade that opened up. The railway The Ethio-Djibouti Railway was built in 1897-1917 and served as Ethiopia's main transport link for many decades. Prior to the construction of the railway, it took six weeks to travel from the coast to Addis Ababa by camel and mule caravan. The beautiful building was eventually abandoned once the railway stopped and 10-12 years ago, the building itself was almost demolished had it not been for a citizens campaign to save La Gare...



# FROM HISTORICAL TO EXCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT



Today thankfully the building of La Gare remains albeit only to serve as a nostalgic memory with pictures from days gone by and a few old train cars on tracks behind the building. There are two cafes (the original Café Choche and Tomoca) and rumours about an eventual French Museum about the Railway. The main purpose now however is to showcase the transformation taking place at La Gare, a joint venture development project between Eagle Hills Ethiopia and The City Government of Addis Ababa. One La Gare when completed will feature more than 4,000 residences set in an area of over 360,000 sqm including commercial, hospitality, retail and leisure attractions within a gated community around a green park. On the outer perimeters of this exclusive complex in theory, low-cost condominiums will also be built for the Kirkos residents.

Bisrat Shibabaw was born in Addis Ababa in 1965. She graduated in 1985 from the Addis Ababa University Alle School of Fine Arts and Design, where she also works as an Instructor. She completed her Master's Degree at the St. Petersburg Academy of Arts in Russia. "Moonlight Sonata," was painted while she listened to Beethoven's composition of the same title. In this work, Shibabaw envisions night skies within three lunar fields teeming with fluorescent constellations of swarming insects and shooting stars. This multi-sensory installation, illuminated by blacklighting and Beethoven's music playing softly in the background is a part of "Breaking the Frame: Women Artists in the Harn Collections." In addition to many solo and group shows in Ethiopia, she also participated in several group exhibitions around the world like at the Harn Museum of Arts, USA (2007), as well as in China and France.

# TEXTILE PIONEER ELIZABETH KASSA

A pioneer in the world of textiles, Elizabeth Kassa of Trio Craft has sadly passed away. Along with her sister Aster, she created the social enterprise of Trio Craft Ethiopia with the prime objective of generating local employment and providing sustainable skills; Trio Craft established itself as a forerunner in the production of beautiful hand woven textiles made from natural and organic Ethiopian materials such as cotton, silk and wool. The company enables Ethiopians (both men and women) with training and sustainable employment providing employment for over 200 people. The company gives priority to employing women, youth, and school dropouts including unemployed single mothers. In the Sarris workshop and showroom, including sewing, embroidery and dyeing, products are beautifully hand woven on traditional looms using traditional skills. Much emphasis with the establishment of Trio Craft was the specific preservation of traditional artisanal skills and highlighting cultural heritage. The exquisite textiles include linens, cushions, scarves and carpets.

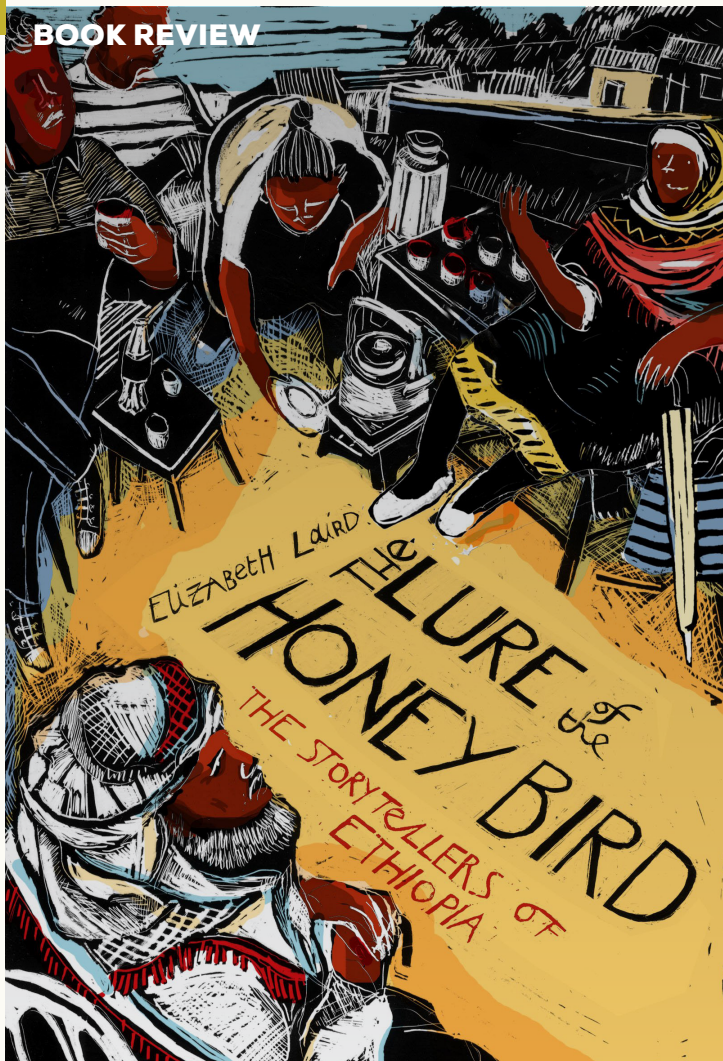

Elizabeth Laird was no stranger to Ethiopia when she embarked on a journey around the different regions to gather the stories which, with the passing of time, the influences of technology and education and the disappearance of some minority languages, risk being lost forever. She first went out to Ethiopia as a teacher in the time of Haile Selassie I and returned thirty years later to witness the changes that had taken place.

Each journey she made, however difficult it was at times, uncovered a wealth of rich tales from the men and women that she was introduced to: teachers, soldiers and farmers, young and old. She compares some of the stories to those she read in the Bible or found in the Koran. Their content sometimes teaches a lesson in morality cloaked in humour or suspense.

Elizabeth weaves among the stories her own life experiences: memories from her past and introductions to the people who influenced her. She also tells the history of Ethiopia's people and the turbulent times the country has witnessed. She describes not only the oral traditions of the many people she met, but also their lives and the history of their forefathers. This is told through the tales or explained in the context of the telling of those tales. The themes include romance and adultery sometimes coupled with death and destruction. Some leave you laughing, others may leave you questioning and all are entertaining.

# FILM MAKER HAILE GERIMA

## TO BE HONORED

Ethiopian independent filmmaker Haile Gerima is to be honored by The Academy Museum of Motion Pictures with a special award at a star-studded opening gala in September. Gerima is acclaimed for his portraits of Black urban life in films like "Bush Mama" and "Ashes & Embers." The Ethiopian-born filmmaker will be receiving the inaugural Vantage Award, recognizing artists who have contextualized or challenged dominant narratives in film. Haile Gerima arrived in the United States from his native Gondar (where his father was a director of a theater group and a dramatist and playwright, of which young Haile was a member) to study acting and directing at the Goodman Theater in Chicago, Illinois. He taught at Howard University's Department of Radio, Television, and Film (Washington DC) where he influenced young filmmakers for over twenty-five years. Gerima's films are noted for their exploration of the issues and history pertinent to members of the African diaspora, from the continent itself to the Americas and Western Hemisphere. What distinguishes his films are that the narratives are told from the perspectives of Africans and members of the African Diaspora itself, rather than being sanitized and misinterpreted by more commercially oriented filmmakers. Gerima's unique filmmaking aesthetic is coupled with a personal mission to correct long-held misconceptions about Black peoples' varied histories throughout the world; for this reason, he is considered--by colleagues and students alike--to be a master teacher in the classroom and behind the camera.

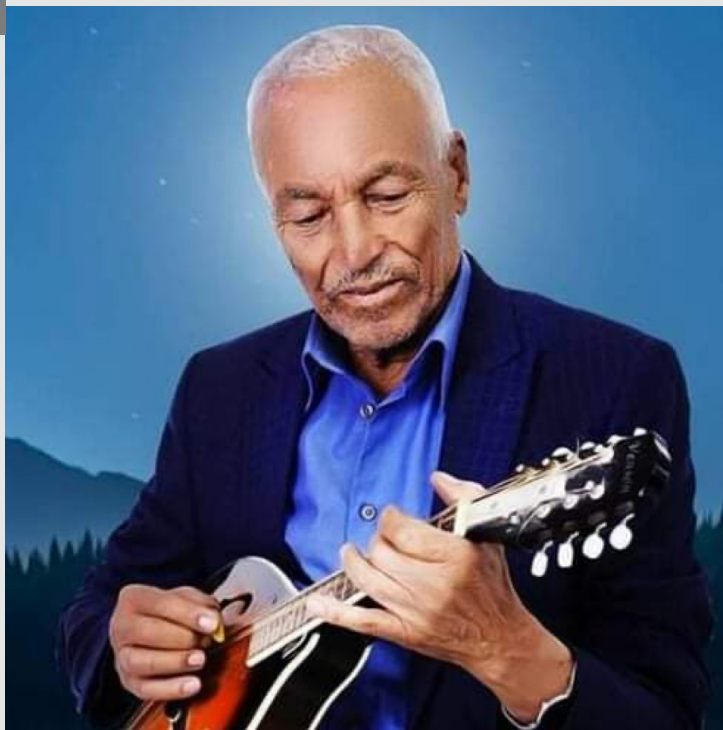
## COLLABORATES WITH H&M



Liya Kebede has been quietly working to preserve the art of weaving in Ethiopia since she founded her artisanal brand Lemlem, which means “to bloom” and “flourish” in Amharic, in 2007. By employing traditional weavers and breaking their cycle of poverty – the once thriving industry creating custom habesha kemis garments suffered as young Africans turned to modern imported fashion – Kebede has reinvigorated a community, and kept an important element of the culture of Addis Ababa, where she was born, alive.

Kebede is working with H&M on ways the western high-street giant can benefit the Lemlem Foundation. The UN ambassador and maternal health advocate’s craft-focused business model can be seen as a lesson in sustainability – one that is spoken about less frequently than eco-friendly textile innovations and circularity initiatives. “Lemlem is about the human element of sustainability. In philanthropy, there’s always this issue of making something sustainable. For me, enabling and educating people, giving them jobs and making them independent is a sustainable way of doing aid.” The work of the Lemlem Foundation, which runs in tandem with the clothing brand and connects female artisans in Africa to healthcare, education and jobs, struck a chord with H&M, a pioneer in the high-street sustainable fashion movement. When the Swedish fast-fashion giant invited Kebede to design a capsule collection, she didn’t balk at the prospect, but saw it as an opportunity to spread the word about Lemlem’s mission. “The idea of H&M collaborating with a brand like ours, which is very much based on sustainability, brings that kind of awareness to their customers,” Kebede explains of H&M’s mammoth outreach.

# GASHE AYELE MAMO

## LEGENDARY MANDOLIN PLAYER

After a short illness, much beloved and well respected musician Gashe Ayele Mamo sadly passed away in April at the age of 79. A regular artist on the music scene of the 1950ies, Mamo was both an accomplished song writer and a mandolin player. Amazingly self-taught, he began playing the mandolin during the period in Ethiopia which was much influenced by the Italians. The mandolin was an Italian instrument but Ayele Mamo adapted his playing so that the instrument took on the distinct and uniquely melodic sound of the Ethiopian Krar. Whilst passing days quietly at home, he was contacted by a young up and coming musician Girum Mezmir. Girum was a multi skilled musician and had a passion for the accordion; he lamented the loss of the old instruments like the accordion and mandolin which had been so popular earlier in the century. An idea came to his mind to create a band that would acknowledged the era of great Ethiopian music from the 1950ies and 60ies and to bring these sounds and old instruments "back to life". He sought out special musicians who would help him achieve this vision to life including Ayele who was happily taken out of "retirement; "his mandolin dusted off and a wonderful new musical career relaunched attracting a whole new audience. In 2008 Addis Acoustic Project was the new group that everyone in town wanted to hear and the band quickly found an audience both locally and internationally eager to hear the nostalgic sounds of acoustic Ethiopian jazz. Gashe Ayele Mamo was as much loved as a performer by his fellow musicians as he was by the audience. A gentleman from an earlier era who today will be greatly missed by both the older and younger generation.

May he Rest in Peace.



The renowned bariatric Surgeon Professor recently has passed away at age of 79. Born into a family of 9 in a rural area where there were no schools, he tended cows and goats from the time he was a small child. At age 12 he left his village of Wonchi to attend school in Addis Ababa. Without any funds, he performed odd jobs to finance his studies.

# MITIKU BELACHEW

With a high school diploma in hand, he went to study medicine in Belgium where he specialized in digestive surgery. Facing the distress of many patients who were often between life and death, Prof. Mitiku invented a ring that is inserted in the upper part of the stomach under laparoscopy. He developed the Laparoscopic Adjustable Gastric Banding (LAGB) technique for the treatment of morbid obesity and he is one of the pioneer surgeons for laparoscopic surgery. Surgical workshops were organized and Prof. Belachew trained more than 300 surgeons from all over the world on how to perform this procedure.

Today, more than one million people have been operated on around the world using this remarkable technique.

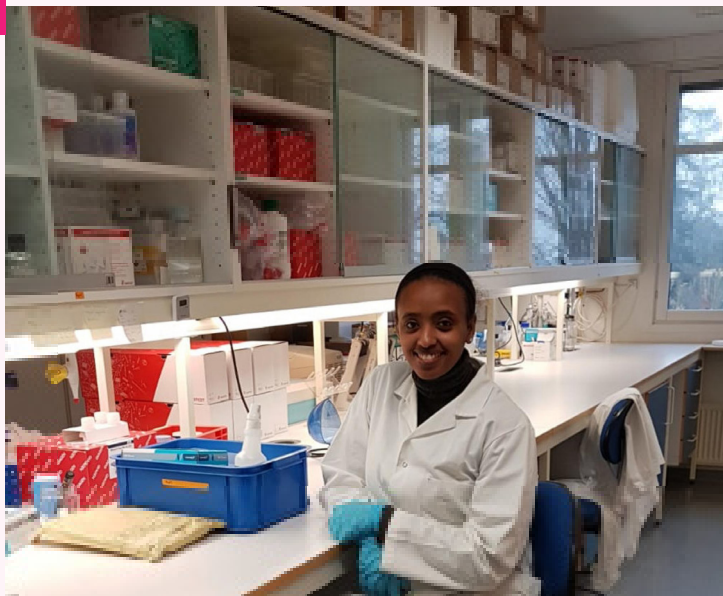

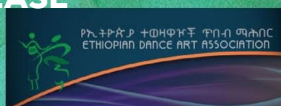
# INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY 2021

## FUTURE WOMEN LEADERS

As the world marked International Women's Day, women in Africa are making significant strides forward in science, technology and innovation. Selamawit Araya Kidane is on her journey to become one of the few nematologists in Ethiopia and indeed Africa. Her research is on Enset (False Banana), Ethiopia's underestimated "saviour" crop.

Selam obtained a BSc in Horticulture. Plant pathology was a significant area of her undergraduate studies and how she came across nematodes. Nematodes can be found living in soil and water, where they feed on microorganisms and organic debris. They can also be parasitic, causing significant harm to people, animals and plants. Her research aims to investigate the impact of plant parasitic nematodes on enset, and how the damage that these pests cause on this particular crop can be managed. Enset is an important staple food crop in the country, with approximately 20% of the population depending on it. Although wild enset can be found across Africa, it has only been domesticated in Ethiopia. In the Southwest of Ethiopia where enset is primarily cultivated, it is a culturally and agriculturally symbolic crop, providing food security, cash income, animal feed, as well as preventing erosion and soil loss on the steep highlands. Enset remains marginalised by researchers, with minimal scientific studies conducted on it. As such, this research is groundbreaking in many ways.. For the first time, the role is evaluated of planting material in the spread of these pests and assessed common varieties for potential resistance against them.

Dance and dance artists play important roles in preserving and promoting Ethiopia's diverse cultural heritage and in developing the country's cultural industry. Currently in Ethiopia, dance is considered an undesirable career, and dancers suffer from low and unstable income, job insecurity, and lack of collective representation. Furthermore, women dance artists face discrimination due to gender, including demands of family responsibilities, and sexual harassment at work. Artists outside of Addis Ababa have even fewer opportunities and resources.

Ethiopian Dance Art Association convenes dancers to foster connectivity, to support infrastructure start-up and to develop a strategic plan. EDAA leadership remains steadfast in its commitment to ensure dance's inclusion in Ethiopia's cultural policy.

This IFCD-funded project aims to structurally professionalize and raise the profile of the dance sector in Ethiopia and contribute to better economic and social outcomes for dancers, specifically women. EDAA will achieve this through a two-year implementation plan which will include activities such as outreach, networking and data collection, and through the publication of written and visual data. EDAA will reach a target of 50% women beneficiaries and closely collaborate with professional organizational structures and universities to incorporate outcomes into forums organized by the Ministry of Culture and Tourism.

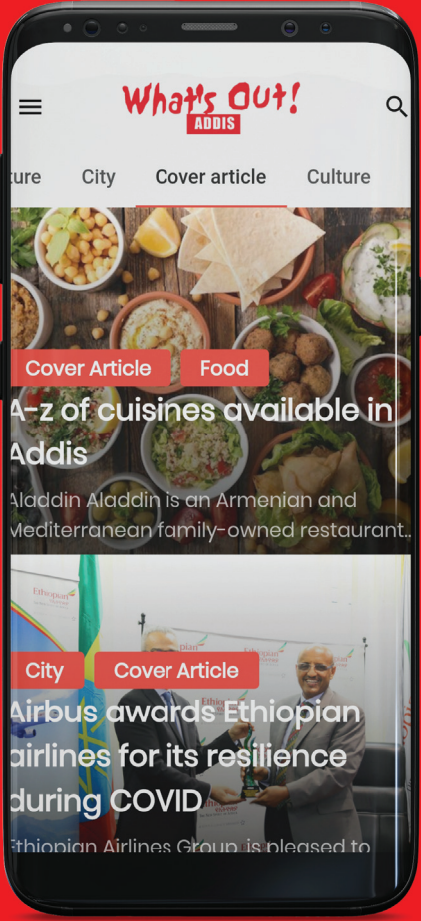
