# The Kindest One music album



## RENOWNED MUSICIAN JORGA MESFIN RELEASES DEBUT ALBUM

Musician Jorga Mesfin's debut album marks a significant milestone in the realm of Ethio-jazz, showing his exceptional talent as a saxophonist and composer. He is a self-taught musician whose influences span the spirit and innovation of jazz and the ancient and diverse sounds found in Ethiopian music.

Jorga Mesfin is widely regarded as one of the most talented contemporary musicians and composers in Ethiopia. Mesfin's journey began at the age of 17, leading to collaborations with esteemed artists such as Mahmoud Ahmed, Aster Aweke, and Vijay Iyer. His residency at Astatke's African Jazz Village in Addis Ababa further shaped his musical prowess.

With this debut album, Mesfin continues to push the boundaries of Ethio-jazz, cementing his position as a visionary in the genre.

## KEITH BOYD: NEVER SAY NEVER!

Keith Boyd recently ran the entire length of Africa from Cape Town to Cairo, breaking the Guinness World Record and inspiring youth across the continent.

Keith, a 57-year-old South African with a genetic heart condition and asthma, completed his run in Metema, a border town between Ethiopia and Sudan, last month. On May 22, 2024, he made history by finishing his run in 301 days, 20 hours, and 58 minutes, surpassing the previous record by nearly 17 days.

The previous record, set by British runner Nicholas Bourne in 1998, was 318 days. Keith began his ambitious journey in July 2023, and after roughly 10 months, 9 countries, and 11,000 kilometers, he finished victoriously in Ethiopia. His journey was filled with challenges

and adversities. The instability in northern Ethiopia forced him to run out of sequence. After covering more than 1,000 kilometers in Ethiopia, he encountered a life-threatening incident, prompting him to drive to Sudan to continue. Sudan, amidst conflict, required him to navigate an easterly route to reach Egypt safely. He concluded his run at the Cairo Towers with fewer hardships but had to return two months later to complete a skipped segment in northern Ethiopia, finishing in Metema.

Keith faced extreme physical pain, sickness, legal barriers, and many more hardships, making the run seem impossible. However, with unwavering determination, he achieved his goal. He aims to use his recognition to inspire African youth to become agents of change and participate in elections, showing that if a 57-year-old with a genetic heart condition and asthma can achieve such a feat, they can realize their dreams through perseverance.

Having worked with Keith during the leg of his journey in Ethiopia, I witnessed his courage and endurance firsthand. One big lesson I learnt from this journey would be: "Never say never!"

# NO-KNEAD TURKISH BREAD

MAKES: 1 medium loaf  
 PREPARATION: 20 min  
 COOKING: 13 min

## INGREDIENTS

- 250 g / 2 cups bread flour
- 7 g / 0.25 oz / 2¼ tsp instant dried yeast
- 200 ml / ¾ cup + 4 tsp warm water
- 2 tsp caster/fine sugar
- 1 tsp fine salt
- 15 ml / 1 tbsp olive oil, for glazing
- Handful of white and black sesame seeds

## METHOD

1. Mix the flour, sugar and salt in a large mixing bowl.

2. Create a small well in the middle of the flour and add the yeast. Pour the water into the well and mix everything together with your hands. At this stage, the dough should be very wet and fairly hard to manage.

3. Cover the mixing bowl with cling film and leave to prove for about one hour (or until it has doubled in size).





4. Flour a work surface and tip the proven dough out onto the work surface making sure to add lots of flour to avoid sticking. Shape the dough into a flat circle (about 2-3 cm high).

5. Place the dough on an olive oil-greased baking tray. Cover the dough with a tea towel and leave to prove for another 45 minutes. Preheat the oven to 250° C / 480° F in the last 20 minutes of this time.

6. Dent the top of the dough by first drawing a rough inner circle (with your fingertips) of about 3 cm from the edge of the bread. Then fill in the centre of the inner circle with criss-crossed diagonal lines about 2-3 cm apart.

7. Using a pastry brush, coat the top of the bread with olive oil. Sprinkle with black and white sesame seeds and press the seeds in as far as you can to make sure that they stay in the bread.

8. Bake the bread for 8 minutes at 250° C / 480° F and then turn the oven down to 200° C / 390° F and bake for another 5 minutes (or until golden brown).

# "THIS IS MY MOMENT"

## Synopsis

Biniam Girmay, a promising 17-year-old cyclist from Eritrea, dreams of one day riding the Tour de France, the most prestigious Grand Tour in the world. For years he thought the Tour was only for European or white cyclists, as throughout its more than 100 editions, only a handful of the participants were black. Biniam's evolving performances give a rare insight into cycling in Africa.

However, to make it into an international pro team, Europe's visa procedures are a constant hassle. And once he marries in Eritrea and becomes a father, the distance of 6.000kms takes its toll. Against all odds, Biniam climbs up the international rankings. When at age 21, he wins his first 'Classic', he proves African riders can win big races. He becomes a cycling hero overnight, but can he change cycling forever?

"This is my moment" gives a unique insight into Biniam Girmay's climb to success and to adulthood. For more than six years, Lieven Corthouts was the only friend and filmmaker allowed to film Biniam's life in Eritrea as well as in Europe. Having Biniam also filming with a vlogging camera, they made this film together in a co-creation process which resulted in this documentary. You get a unique insight into the journey of 'Bini' to the top and all the obstacles that came along his way. What started as a 17-year-old Eritrean cycling talent had a historic climax on Sunday, March 27, 2022, at Gent-Wevelgem in Flanders Fields. Girmay became the first African ever to win a cycling classic.

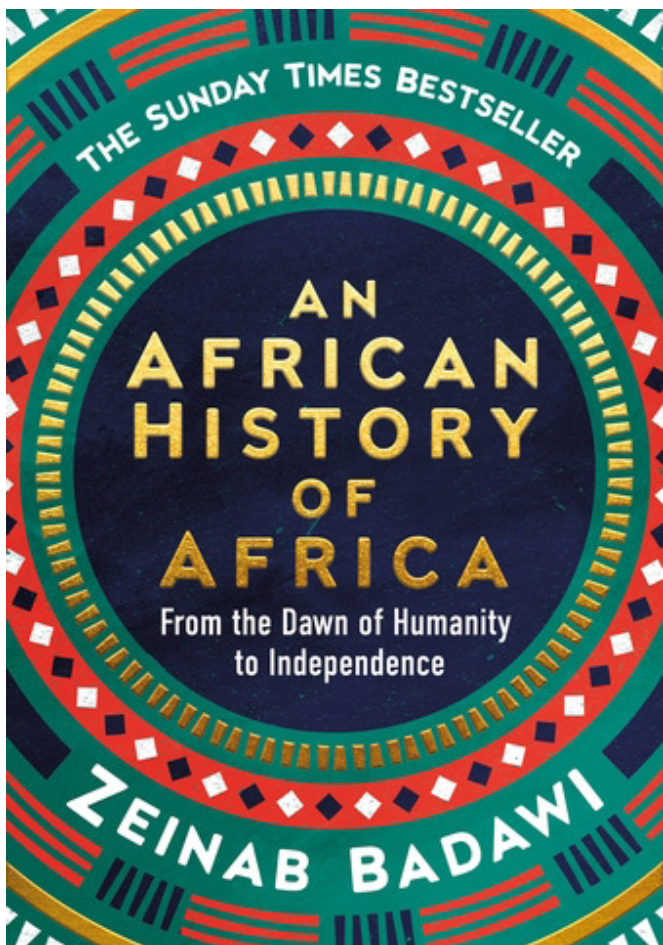

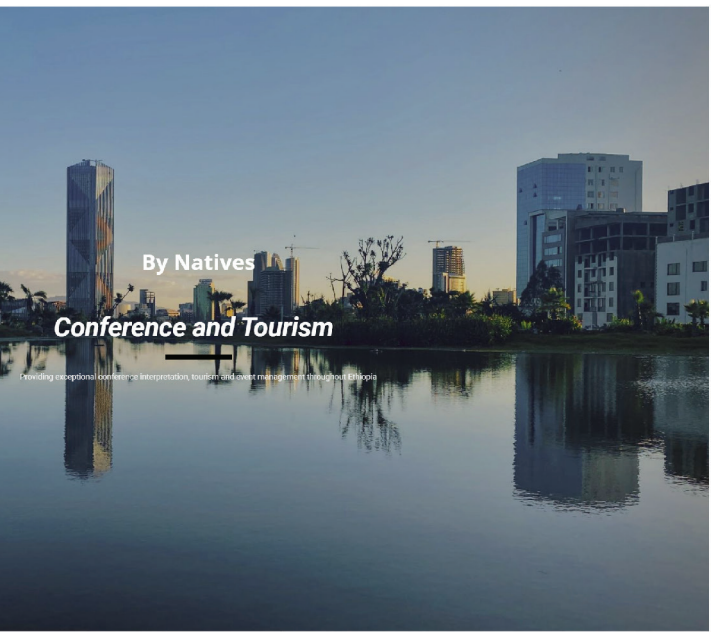

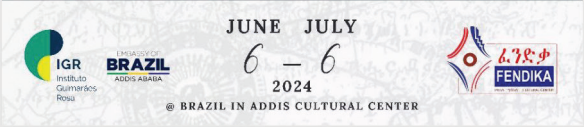

# RESTORING THE HISTORIC AL-NEJASHI MOSQUE

*Al-Nejashi is said to be the first mosque in Africa. It is named after Nejashi, ruler of the Kingdom of Aksum, who hosted companions of the Prophet Muhammad who escaped persecution in Mecca*





In May 2024, Ethiopian and Turkish officials announced the final stages of initiating the restoration of the Al-Nejashi Mosque, a historic landmark significant to both nations. The Al-Nejashi Mosque, believed to be the first mosque built in Africa, also holds deep significance for Muslims worldwide. The restoration project will ensure this historic landmark is preserved for generations to come.

H.E. Amb. Berk Baran, Ambassador of the Republic of Türkiye to Ethiopia, and Mr. Enver Resulogullari, the new Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency (TIKA) Program Coordinator, met with State Ministers of Tourism to discuss the final steps for the project. These steps include kicking off the restoration work and coordinating the official handover of the site in the next few months.

The restoration will be overseen by a team of experts identified by TIKA and supervised by the Ethiopian Heritage Authority and the Regional Culture and Tourism Bureau. This collaborative approach ensures the project adheres to the highest conservation standards while respecting the mosque's cultural significance.

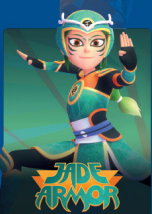
