GRAND REOPENING OF AFRICA HALL



DECEMBER 2024



In 1963, the Charter of the Organization of African Unity was signed in Africa Hall, one of the most significant achievements of unity for Africa during the postcolonial period. It is because of that achievement that the African Union exists today.

It is important to recognize the role of Ethiopia in fostering that achievement through the generous donation of Emperor Haile Selassie. Africa Hall is one of the most prominent examples of African heritage and a symbol of African culture, history, and aspirations for peace and unity on the continent.

The 1961 Arturo Mezzèdimi modernist masterpiece, designed as a meeting place for African nation-states and headquarters for the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA) has recently undergone extensive renovations including the interiors, integrated artworks, furniture, and landscape setting. The renovations were commissioned by UNECA and led by Australian firm Architectus Conrad Gargett to meet modern international standards while preserving its historical significance and Mezzèdimi's original design.

For the public, the visitor experience now includes a new museum, exhibition space, and a new separate Visitor Center with a ground-floor café where the 1960's interior was reconstructed.

The refurbished building was re-inaugurated on 21 October 2024 in the presence of H.E. Dr Abiy Ahmed, Prime Minister of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia; H.E. António Guterres, Secretary General of the United Nations; H.E. Mohamed Ould Cheikh El Ghazouani, President of the Islamic Republic of Mauritania and Chair of the African Union for 2024; and H.E. Moussa Faki Mahamat, Chairperson of the African Union Commission.

SURMA: ETHIOPIA'S UNTAMED BEAUTY!



In a world where technology and globalization are reshaping our daily lives, the people of the South Omo and West Omo Zones in Ethiopia beg to differ. These tribes, living in remote corners of the country and largely isolated from modern influences, have preserved their ancient cultures and traditions. They maintain a deep connection with their natural environment—the forests, rivers, mountains, and valleys—holding onto their own definitions of beauty, knowledge, and morals.



Among these remarkable tribes are the Surma/ Suri. The Suri people of southwestern Ethiopia are agro-pastoralists residing in remote villages along the Kibish River, a tributary of the larger Omo River that flows into Lake Turkana. They cultivate crops such as sorghum, cassava, spices, and tobacco. During the dry season, the Suri also harvest honey. Cattle are central to their sustenance, with the average married male owning between 30 and 40 cows, which are typically only slaughtered for ceremonial purposes.

Suri women are known for their striking decorations, including clay plates worn on their lips and earlobes, body scarification, and brightly colored flowers adorning their heads. A truly unique way of defining beauty in their own style!

The Surma also practice Donga, a stick-fighting tournament that happens once a year. The young boys of Surma gather once a year to face each other in a battle that determines their status in the tribe to become chief, to be able to marry, to transition from boyhood to becoming a man, and to show their bravery.

For the curious traveler seeking an authentic experience of untamed beauty and genuine culture, I recommend visiting Surma—you will return with unforgettable memories!

GRILLED EGGPLANT AND CHICKPEA SALAD WITH MINT YOGURT DRESSING

INGREDIENTS

For the Salad:

- 2 medium eggplants, sliced into rounds (about ½ inch thick)
- 1 ½ cups cooked chickpeas (or 1 can, drained and rinsed)
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 2 cups fresh arugula
- 2 tbsp olive oil (for grilling)
- Salt and black pepper to taste

For the Mint Yogurt Dressing:

- 1 cup plain Greek yogurt (or dairy-free yogurt for vegan option)
- 2 tbsp fresh mint leaves, finely chopped



- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 tbsp lemon juice
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- ¼ tsp salt
- 2-3 tbsp water (to adjust consistency)

PREPARATION

Step 1: Grill the Eggplant

1. Preheat a grill or grill pan over medium-high heat.
2. Brush both sides of the eggplant slices with olive oil and season with salt and pepper.
3. Grill the eggplant for 4-5 minutes per side, or until tender and lightly charred.
4. Remove from the grill and set aside to cool slightly.

Step 2: Prepare the Mint Yogurt Dressing

1. In a small bowl, whisk together the Greek yogurt, olive oil, lemon juice, garlic, salt, and chopped mint.
2. Add water, one tablespoon at a time, until the dressing reaches your desired consistency (thick but pourable).
3. Taste and adjust the seasoning if necessary (add more lemon for extra tang or salt to taste).

Step 3: Assemble the Salad

1. In a large serving bowl or platter, spread a bed of arugula.
2. Add the grilled eggplant slices, chickpeas, and cherry tomatoes on top of the arugula.
3. Drizzle the mint yogurt dressing generously over the salad.

Step 4: Add Finishing Touches

1. Garnish with extra mint leaves or a drizzle of olive oil, if desired.
2. Add a sprinkle of feta cheese or a handful of toasted pine nuts for extra richness and crunch.
3. Serve immediately, while the eggplant is still slightly warm. Pairs well with grilled pita bread.
