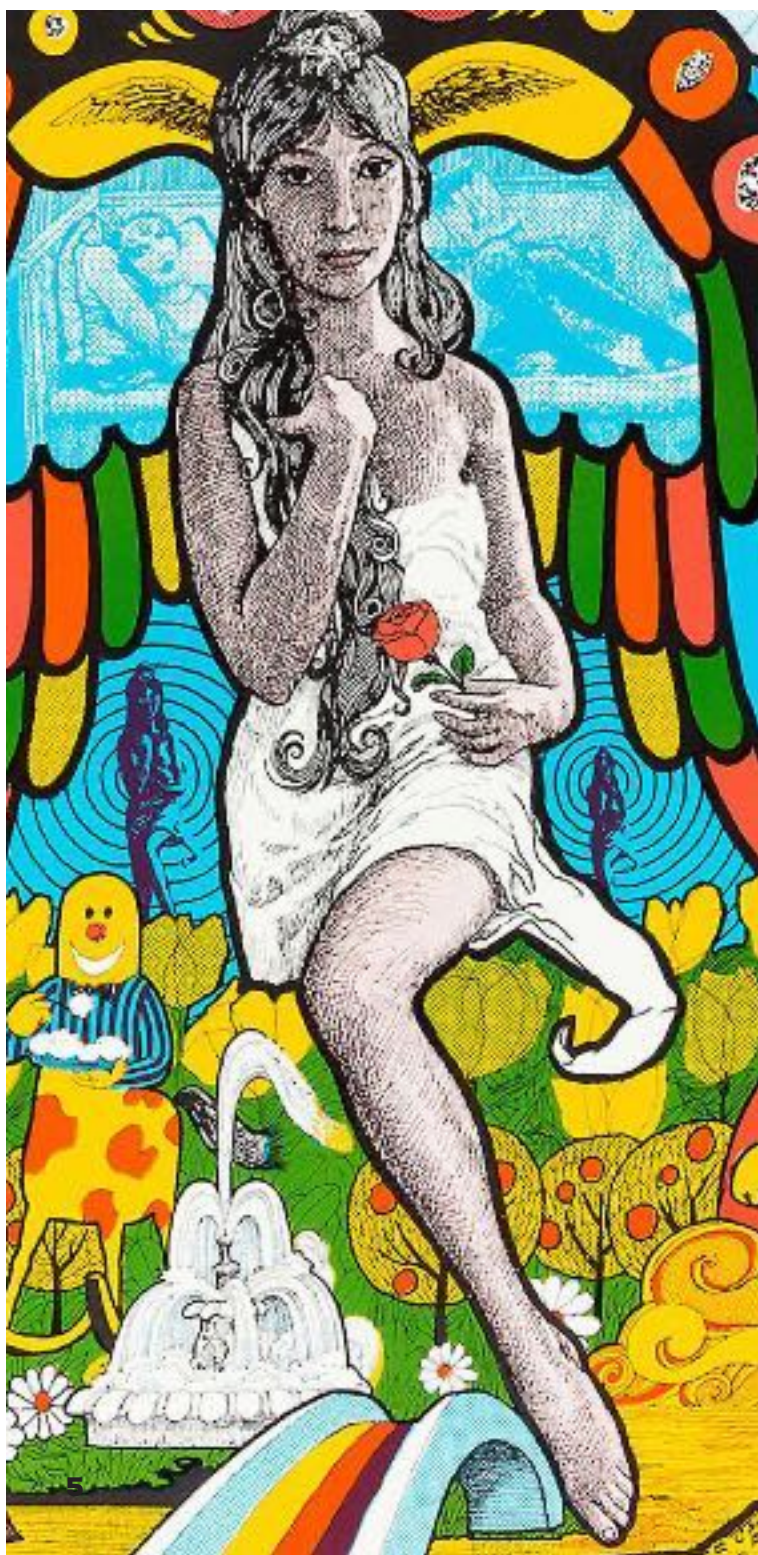
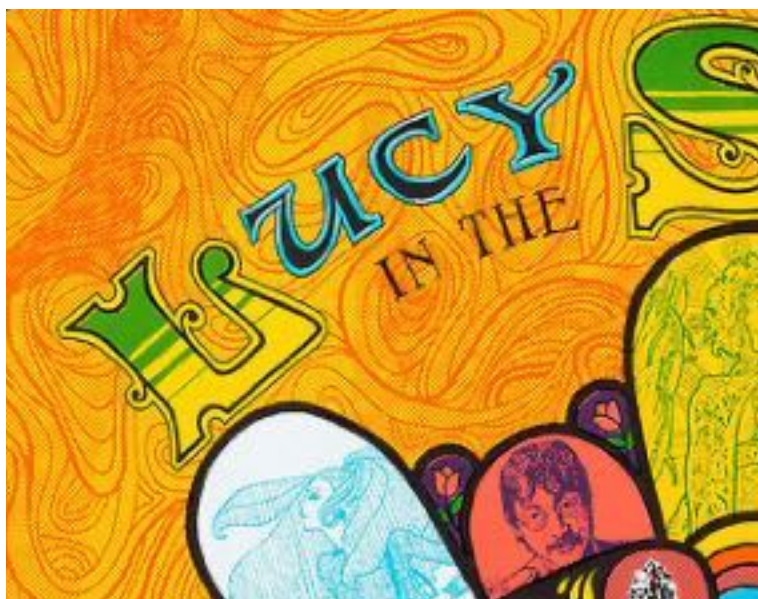

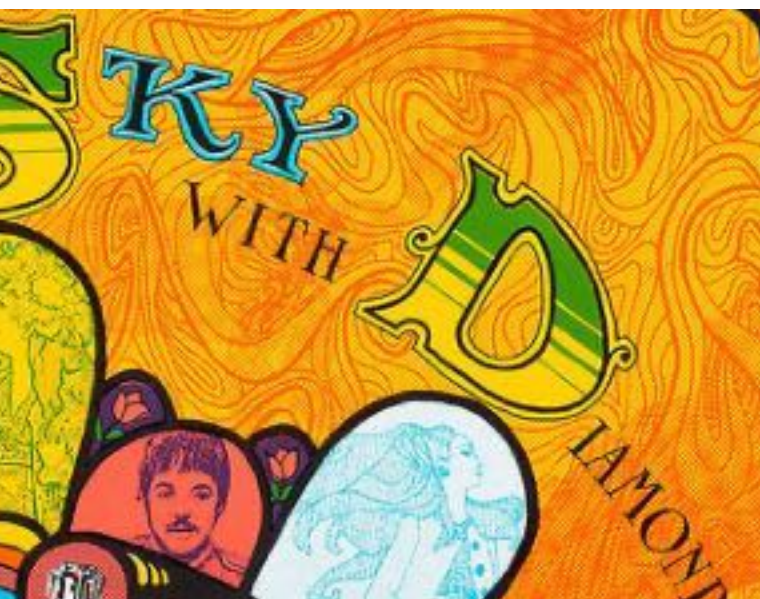

NIGHT OF IDEAS: CELEBRATING THE DISCOVERY OF LUCY JAN 25, 2025

On January 25, 2024, the **Alliance Ethio-Française** and **Culture Club** will present a unique event, "*Night of Ideas*", commemorating the anniversary of the discovery of Lucy, one of the most significant fossil finds in human history. Unearthed in Ethiopia, *Lucy*, an *Australopithecus afarensis*, has become a cornerstone of our understanding of human evolution. This multidisciplinary evening will combine science, art, and music to honor *Lucy's* legacy and explore her profound cultural and scientific significance.

The event will kick off with a **conference** by **Jean-Renaud Boisserie**, a French archaeologist and expert on the Great Rift Valley, who will discuss the discovery of Lucy and its far-reaching impact on our understanding of human origins. Following the lecture, attendees will be treated to a **screening** of the PBS documentary *In Search of Human Origins*, focusing on Lucy's discovery. Narrated by **Dr. Donald Johanson**, the paleoanthropologist who led the excavation, the documentary provides an in-depth look at this groundbreaking discovery.

The evening will conclude with a **tribute concert** to The Beatles, particularly "**Lucy in the Sky with Diamonds**". Local musicians will reinterpret the iconic song with Ethiopian musical influences, blending the worlds of science and creativity.

Organized in collaboration with the **French Center for Ethiopian Studies (CFEE)**, this event offers a memorable celebration of Lucy's legacy and is open to students, researchers, and the general public.

GHERALTA: CHURCHES IN ROCK



“Pictures are a thousand words”: this saying does not work true for the greatness, majesty and challenges of trekking the mountains of Gheralta. Words, pictures or videos will not do justice to properly convey what one experiences in this area. The mountains, the churches, the humble locals and the villages are all beyond one’s wildest imagination and are something that one can only feel by experiencing it.

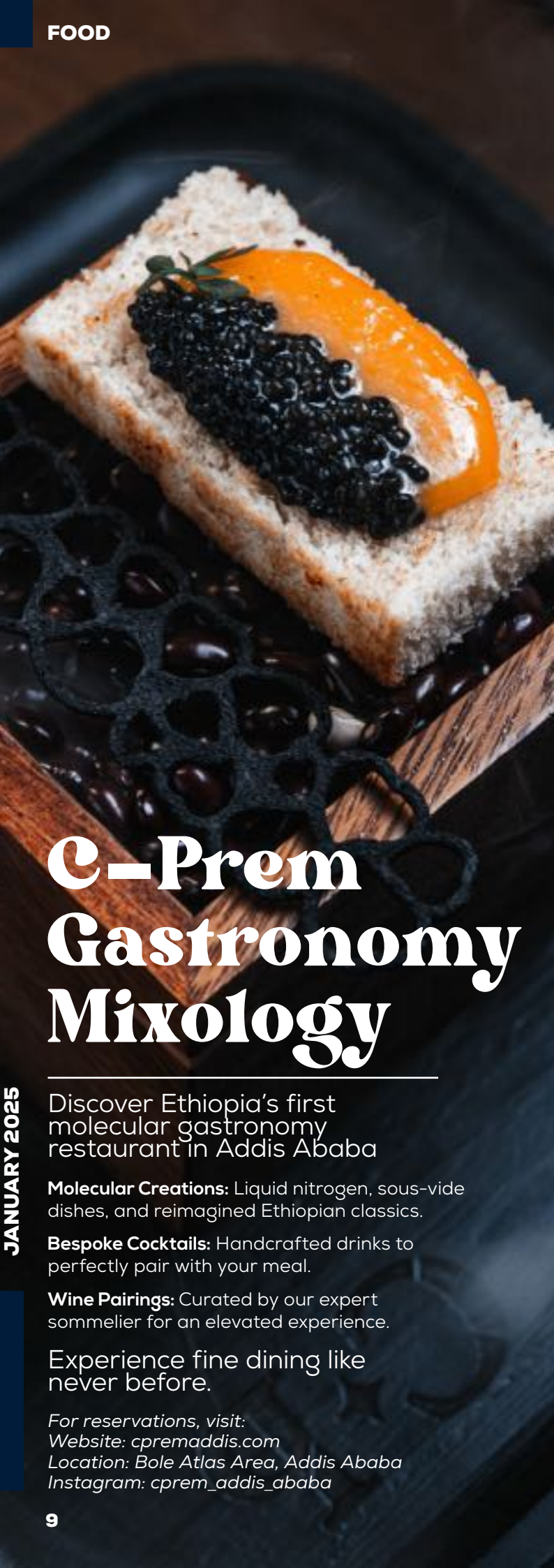
The Gheralta area is home to a number of rock-churches, some famous for their stone workmanship, and ancient paintings, and others known for their magnificent view and difficult ascent. However, there is one church in particular that holds all these together: Abuna Yemaeta Guh.

High in the Gheralta Mountains lies Abuna Yemaeta Guh, an extraordinary rock-hewn church dating back to the 6th century. Its establishment is attributed to Abuna Yemaeta, one of the nine saints who were important to the early growth of Christianity in Ethiopia. This remarkable site is renowned for its thrilling cliffside treks, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape and its beautiful church paintings.

The trek to the church is filled with climbing up and down steep paths and slippery slopes, and the most thrilling challenge just before reaching the church, is climbing a cliff face with only footholds and handgrips.

All these efforts, however, will eventually be rewarded with an unforgettable experience of reaching one of the most inaccessible churches in the world that earned it its nickname “Chapel in the Sky”. The interior of the church has remarkable murals of Old and New Testament stories. It is surprising to see that such great works of art existed in such a place that seems closer to the moon than Earth.

If you're seeking adventure and a deep dive into history, a visit to Abuna Yemaeta Guh church and the Gheralta area will truly be a once in a lifetime experience.

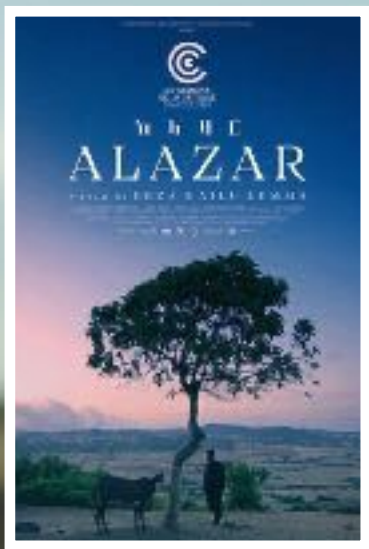

ETHIOPIAN FILM ALAZAR SCREENED AT FILM AFRICA 2024

In **Alazar**, the characters are lost in a vast barren landscape, where nature turned upside down forces them to leave or to stay.

Between religions, miracles, and curses, the filmmaker carries out a skillful investigation in which a quest for balance with our environment remains a distant horizon.

Alazar is a film about disruption in a farming community in contemporary Ethiopia when the patriarch of a prominent family disappears from his grave. Tessema, his son, begins to question the church's divine explanation, forcing him to launch his own investigation.



From excerpts of an interview with Director Beza Hailu Lemma:

“Life is hard in most of rural Ethiopia. People are highly dependent on the crops they farm on their land to make a living. If the annual rain doesn't arrive on time, food shortages are highly likely to happen and if the drought lasts a long time, their only choice is to stay and face hunger or move away. The film takes place in a town in Northern Ethiopia but the story doesn't have a specific time and place. The film contains many perspectives that represent the diverse set of beliefs that exist in the country. The fate of mankind resting on the restoration of balance in nature or a truce with 'God' belongs both to the indigenous ways of life and to Christianity.”

Beza Hailu Lemma is based in Addis Ababa. Passionate about both documentary and fiction, Beza has made several short films including *Katanga Nation* (2022) which screened in over 20 film festivals worldwide.

Film Africa is the celebration of African and African diaspora cinema presented by the Royal African Society.

FLU/COLD TEA BOMBS RECIPE

INGREDIENTS

- 2 whole lemons (peeled)
- 2 large bunches of fresh ginger
- 1 whole head of garlic
- 2 tablespoons turmeric
- 1 tablespoon black pepper
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon
- 1 ½ tablespoons cayenne pepper (optional, adjust for spice preference)
- ½ tablespoon apple cider vinegar (ACV)
- 1 ½ tablespoons honey (or substitute with maple syrup/agave for vegan option)
- 3 cups water

INSTRUCTIONS

- Prepare the Ingredients:
- Peel the lemons and chop them into smaller pieces to make blending easier.
- Peel and chop the fresh ginger into chunks.
- Separate and peel the garlic cloves from the whole head.

Blend:

- In a high-speed blender, combine the peeled lemons, ginger, garlic, turmeric, black pepper, cinnamon, cayenne pepper (if using), apple cider vinegar, honey, and water.
- Blend until the mixture is smooth.

Strain:

- Using a fine mesh sieve or, preferably, a cheesecloth, strain the mixture to remove the pulp and solids, leaving you with a smooth liquid.
- Discard the solids or compost them.

Freeze:

- Pour the strained liquid into a silicone muffin tray or ice cube tray. Each portion should be about 1/8 cup (2 tablespoons).
- Freeze until solid, about 4-6 hours or overnight.

Store:

- Once frozen, remove the tea bombs from the tray and transfer them to an airtight container or freezer bag. Store them in the freezer for up to 3 months.





JEAN-MICHEL BASQUIAT: IMPRESSION OF AFRICA

“A visual dialogue exploring the intersection of Basquiat’s legacy with Ethiopian contemporary art”

Presented by the Alliance Ethio-Française in collaboration with Culture Club, Jean-Michel Basquiat: Impression of Africa exhibition is designed to create a bridge between the visual rebellion of Basquiat and the deeply rooted traditions and contemporary challenges of Ethiopian art. Through shared themes of identity, spirituality, cultural heritage, and the fight for recognition, the works spark a powerful visual conversation, shedding light on the universality of these struggles.

Basquiat’s rise from New York street graffiti to global fame in the 1980s marked a dramatic shift in the art world. Starting with his “SAMO” graffiti tag, he transformed urban spaces into bold, expressive canvases that challenged both artistic norms and the systemic exclusion of Black artists.

Visitors will experience a full sensory experience of the universe of Basquiat characterized by chaotic energy and powerful narratives. Interactive displays allow guests to engage directly with the art, stepping into the streets of 1980s New York, where Basquiat’s graffiti was both a protest and an artistic statement. Highlights of the exhibition include large-scale Basquiat frescoes, photos of his 1986 trip to Abidjan, and works by over a dozen contemporary artists influenced by his style.

More than just a visual display, Impression of Africa fosters a cultural exchange that connects Basquiat’s pioneering voice to the artistic expressions of contemporary Ethiopian artists, showcasing how struggles for identity and recognition transcend borders and continue to inspire new generations. The exhibition is a testament to the power of art in bridging cultures and generations. It opened at the Alliance Ethio-Française on 14 December 2024 and will run for three months.

The Alliance Ethio-Française, founded in 1907, is a leading cultural institution in Addis Ababa, dedicated to promoting global artistic dialogue and fostering artistic exchange.

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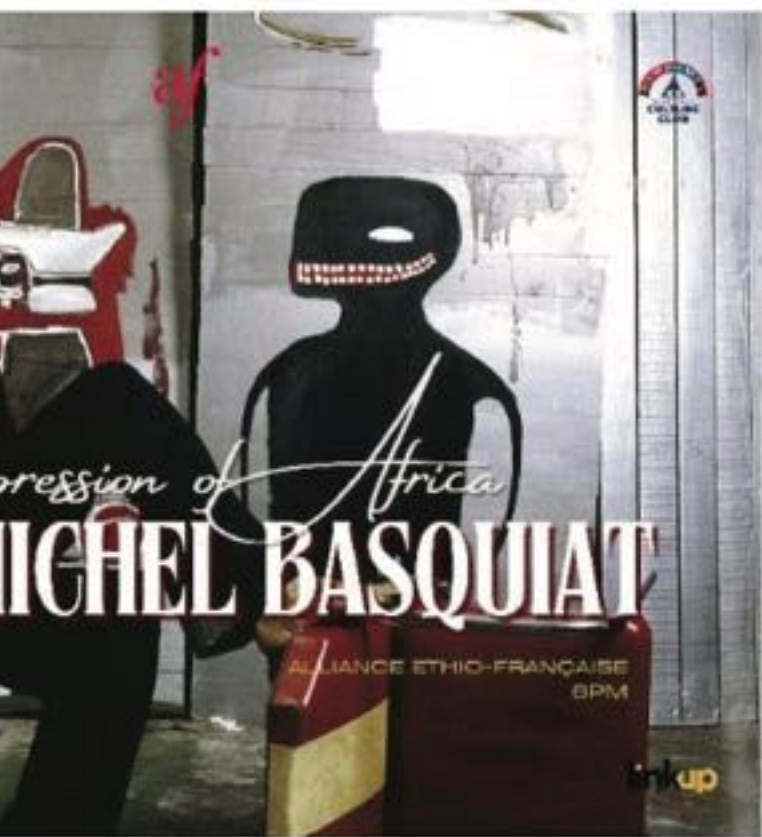

BEYOND BODY AND SPACE

On Thursday, December 12, 2024, the Goethe-Institut Äthiopien's main hall was beautifully transformed for the opening of *Beyond Body and Space*, an immersive soft sculpture installation by artist Isabel Tesfazghi and architect Alebel Desta. In a city where large-scale art installations remain uncommon, this exhibition provided a refreshing experience, blending form and material to encourage visitors to see familiar things in new and exciting ways.

Wrapped in a warm, soft orange glow, the space felt peaceful and alive, inviting exploration. Hanging from the hall's high ceilings, flowing forms made from woven plastic fabric traditionally used for storage, shading, and lightweight shelter, turned the room into a sensory adventure.

Adding depth to the installation, the hanging forms were filled with discarded textiles collected from factories in Addis Ababa. This inclusion gave new life to materials that might otherwise have been discarded, connecting the artwork to the city's dynamic industrial landscape. Below, soft, floral-inspired benches made from the same fabric offered cozy resting spaces, seamlessly linking the art above with the audience's experience on the ground.

The opening night buzzed with energy and excitement as Goethe's vibrant community of



artists, architects, and art enthusiasts gathered to celebrate the work. Outside in the courtyard space, a lively DJ set the mood with music, while inside, shadows played across the walls, and floor, creating a constantly shifting and immersive environment. Visitors wandered through the installation, touching the forms and marveling at how the space seemed to breathe and transform with every movement.

This exhibition was made possible with support from the Institut für Auslandsbeziehungen (ifa), which supports contemporary artists working abroad. The project highlights art's ability to foster cross-cultural dialogue and spark meaningful conversations locally and globally.

Dr. Angelika Eder, Director of the Goethe-Institut Äthiopien, officially inaugurated the exhibition as Isabel Tesfazghi and Alebel Desta shared their journey of collaboration, one filled with exploration, challenges, and nearly two years of planning and production.

Beyond Body and Space will remain open until January 31, 2025. This exhibition is a transformative experience in Addis Ababa's growing art scene, showcasing the power of art to reimagine the overlooked into something beautiful and new. Don't miss out!


