COFFEE, NOT JUST A DRINK: A LIFESTYLE

Ever since the legendary goat herder Kaldi discovered coffee in Ethiopia's Kaffa region, the tradition of coffee has been woven into the lifestyle of Ethiopians. From the households of modern cities to the villages of remote tribes in the Omo Valley, coffee is not just a drink; it's a lifestyle.

Across Ethiopia, coffee is seldom consumed for its caffeine. Instead, people gather to enjoy a cup of coffee to connect and share stories. Just as the small "sini" cups are arranged on the "rekebot" serving table, neighbors, friends, and family come together for a coffee ceremony to cherish this precious gift of Ethiopia.

Here are some of the unique coffee cultures practiced in different parts of Ethiopia. So grab a cup of coffee and read along!

1. Shoforo Coffee in the Hamer Tribe

The Hamer, one of the largest tribes in Ethiopia's south Omo Valley, use only the husk of the coffee cherry, creating a tea-like beverage. The boiled coffee husk is served in a gourd made from a calabash tree and is shared among neighbors and family, with each person taking turns sipping from the same gourd.

2. Buna Qella in the Borana

In the Borana region, coffee beans are boiled in melted butter, creating Buna Qella, often reserved for esteemed guests. The butter-soaked beans are served in clay gourds and passed around, starting with the elders.

3. Kuti Shay in Harar & Southern Ethiopia

Historically, Ethiopian farmers set aside their harvested coffee for trade or special ceremonies. Instead of drinking coffee, they enjoyed "Kuti," a tea made from coffee leaves.

Kuti is prepared by boiling coffee leaves in hot water, often with a pinch of salt or sugar.

Whether you are in the modern coffee shops of Addis Ababa or under the traditional huts of the tribes in the Omo valley, enjoy the flavors of coffee in the land of origins.

AFFINI: AN EPIC NEW ETHIOPIAN FILM

'Affini', an epic Ethiopian film, is making history as the first of its kind to be screened twice at the prestigious New African Film Festival (NAFF) in the USA. It's a culture-centered film made with modern filmmaking techniques, ensuring that its message of justice and reconciliation resonates not only in Ethiopia but around the world. 'Affini' is a Sidamic term that translates to "Have you heard?" It is a powerful expression tied to a traditional reconciliation system still practiced in the Sidama region of Ethiopia. In this system, the community believes that true justice can only be achieved through open dialogue and mutual understanding. Conflicting parties are given an



equal opportunity to voice their perspectives, guided by the wisdom of the Shengos (Council of Elders).

The film dives deep into this rich cultural practice, depicting how the Sidama community navigates conflict, strives for justice, and ultimately restores harmony. It's a thought-provoking universal story that will leave you reflecting on the timeless themes of truth, justice, and the power of community.

'Affini' is brought to life by two talented actors, Girum and Amanuel, who immersed themselves in the Sidamic language and way of life. Their dedication to authenticity shines through in their performances, making the characters feel incredibly real and relatable.

The Plot: A farmer who wants to avenge his son's killer, struggles to keep his daughter from being abducted by the same rogue man within the community who is suspected of killing a family member. He then falls in love with a "modern" woman whom he has nothing in common with who arrived from America to study Anthropology.

RECIPE

GRILLED CORN AND BLACK BEAN BOWLS WITH AVOCADO LIME DRESSING



INGREDIENTS

For the Bowl:

- 2 cups grilled corn (about 3 medium ears or 2 cups canned corn)
- 1 ½ cups black beans (cooked or canned, drained and rinsed)
- 1 red bell pepper, diced
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1 avocado, sliced (for topping)
- 2 cups cooked rice, quinoa, or farro (grain of choice)
- ½ cup red onion, thinly sliced
- ¼ cup cilantro, chopped

For the Avocado Lime Dressing:

- 1 ripe avocado
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 2 tbsp lime juice
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- ¼ tsp salt
- 2-3 tbsp water (to adjust consistency)

Topping:

- Crushed tortilla chips (for crunch)

PREPARATION

Step 1: Prepare the Grains

1. Cook the rice, quinoa, or farro according to the package instructions.
1. Once the grains are ready, fluff them with a fork and let them cool slightly.

Step 2: Grill the Corn

1. If using fresh corn: Brush the corn ears with a little olive oil and grill them over medium-high heat for about 10 minutes, turning occasionally, until the kernels are slightly charred. Let the corn cool, then slice the kernels off the cob.
2. If using canned corn: Heat a grill pan or skillet over medium-high heat and cook the corn until charred in places (about 5-7 minutes).

Step 3: Prepare the Avocado Lime Dressing

1. In a blender or food processor, combine the avocado, olive oil, lime juice, garlic, and salt.
2. Blend until smooth and creamy. Add water a tablespoon at a time to achieve your desired consistency.
3. Taste and adjust seasoning if needed (add more lime juice for extra tang).

Step 4: Assemble the Bowls

1. Divide the cooked grains among bowls.
2. Top with grilled corn, black beans, red bell pepper, cherry tomatoes, red onion, and avocado slices.
3. Drizzle with the avocado lime dressing.

Step 5: Add Toppings

1. Sprinkle crushed tortilla chips over each bowl for a crunchy finish.
2. Garnish with freshly chopped cilantro.

Take a closer look, and you'll see a unique pattern flowing across the outer skin of Lideta Mercato, inspired by the detailed and vivid patterns often seen in Ethiopian women's dresses. This façade allows fresh air and light to pass through while shielding against heat—much like how birds weave their nests for both protection and breathability.

Birds also build with community in mind, nesting together for safety and shared resources. Lideta Mercato embraces this same idea, creating an open, human-centric space that encourages interaction and natural movement—unlike traditional malls that feel closed off.

The truth is simple: Nature has all the best ideas. By learning from birds and buildings like Lideta Mercato, Ethiopian architects can create smarter, greener, and more intuitive spaces. So, next time you see a bird's nest, don't just think, "That's cute!" Think, "That's design genius!"

PHARMACIES TO GO DIGITAL WITH NEW INTEGRATION

Ethiopia, home to 70% of Africa's mountains, boasts breathtaking peaks and challenging trails for adventurers. However, these majestic landscapes also pose significant challenges for the locals. Farming is hard, with rugged terrain leading to erosion and landslides.

MedRafa, a healthcare solutions provider, has partnered with WeVenture Hub to integrate pharmacies across Addis Ababa into the country's digital health ecosystem.

This initiative targets improving e-prescription services, upgrading prescription management, and expanding access to medicines.

Medrafa stated that the platform creates a secure, user-friendly, and scalable system that reduces prescription errors, cuts patient waiting times, and strengthens connections between healthcare stakeholders.

The system provides management tools, including: purchase order management which smoothens medication orders and ensures stock availability; real-time inventory tracking which monitors stock levels and sends alerts for low inventory.

The tools also include expiration date notifications that flags soon-to-expire products to prevent waste, and sales history tracking which records transactions for financial oversight and regulatory compliance.

Ben Tesfaye, co-founder of MedRafa, stated that the e-prescription and pharmacy integration service will launch in the capital city first, with plans for expansion.
